What concerns can I call with?

Any possible violation of Vermont child care regulations, such as lack of supervision, too many children, unqualified or not enough staff, inappropriate guidance and discipline, unsafe environment, and unregulated child care.

Who can call?

Anyone concerned about children can and should call: 1-800-540-7942

What happens?

A licensing specialist contacts the person making the report and then visits the child care in question to address the concerns. A determination is made as to whether the concern is substantiated. If it is, the licensing specialist may require a program improvement plan or other action. The caller will hear back from the licensing specialist after the visit.
